JOB DESCRIPTION: CDL LICENSES A, B AND C

- 1. THE STANDARD WORK WEEK IS MONDAY TO FRIDAY. START TIMES VARY BETWEEN 2 AM AND 7 AM. DRIVERS COVER A RADIUS NOT GREATER THAN 150 MILES FROM OUR AMESBURY LOCATION. THERE ARE NO OVERNIGHT ROUTES.**

- 2. DRIVER'S DUTIES:**
 - A. DRIVER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR UNLOADING UP TO 16 PALLETS OF FOOD PRODUCTS AND DELIVERING AND THE PRODUCT TO OUR CUSTOMERS LOCATIONS. THERE ARE USUALLY 12 TO 20 DELIEVERIES PER ROUTE. TRUCKS HAVE DAILY DELIVERY WEIGHTS OF 8,000 TO 14,000 LBS. OF PRODUCT WITH THE HEAVIEST SINGLE ITEM WEIGHING APPROX. 100 LBS. THE DRIVER IS REQUIRED TO UNLOAD PRODUCT BY STACKING IT ON A LOAD DOLLY. THE RAMP AT THE REAR OF THE TRUCK IS USED FOR THE "DRY" AND "PRODUCE" ITEMS. "FROZEN" PRODUCTS ARE DELIVERED BY USING THE SIDE FREEZER DOOR. EACH TRUCK HAS A SIDE STEP AND HAND RAILS WHICH ALLOW THE DRIVER TO ACCESS FREEZER COMPARTMENT OF THE TRUCK. THE DRIVER MUST PULL THE RAMP OUT WHEN MAKING DELIVERIES THEN PUSH IT BACK INTO PLACE WHEN COMPLETED. THE RAMP WEIGHS APPROXIMATELY 100LBS. DRIVER'S USUALLY STACK THE DOLLY WITH 250 – 300LBS. OF PRODUCT, GUIDE IT DOWN THE RAMP FROM THE BACK OF THE TRUCK AND WHEEL IT INTO THE CUSTOMER'S BUILDING. THEY ARE OFTEN REQUIRED TO PULL THE LOADED DOLLY UP STEPS AND STAIRS OR GUIDE IT DOWN A FLIGHT OF STAIRS. DRIVERS MUST BE CAPABLE OF CLIMBING IN AND OUT OF THE VEHICLE.**

 - B. DAILY "CIRCLE CHECKS" ARE PERFORMED BY THE DRIVER.**

 - C. DRIVERS ARE EXPECTED TO DO "BACK HAULS" OF PRODUCT IF NEEDED.**
